HEALTH & NUTRITION TIPS FROM THE HEALTH MINISTRY: Vitamin K, part

2: Vitamin K2 is found mainly in animal products and fermented foods but is also produced by the gut bacteria. Your body can also convert some of your K1 to K2. Vitamin K2 is an extremely important vitamin as it is associated with many health benefits. One important function of K2 is calcium metabolism. Calcium buildup around your heart and in your arteries is a major risk for heart disease and K2 helps allocate calcium to your bones. This capacity reduces the potential for osteoporosis while simultaneously reducing calcification of your blood vessels and arteries, atherosclerosis, and calcium deposits in your soft tissues and organs. To reverse heart disease and clear out calcium deposits in soft tissues and organs, K2 is an essential tool. Vitamin K2 is also a critical nutrient for dental and oral health. It decreases calcified dental plaque, has a protective effect against gum disease, prevents cavities, helps keep the oral microbiome balanced and supports mineralization of tooth enamel.

Vitamin K2 enhances insulin sensitivity and blood sugar control, it has also been shown to help slow the progression of neurological diseases such as Alzheimer's and multiple sclerosis. Next week we'll continue to discuss vitamin K.
