Reading Radical Romans: The Apostle Paul's Letter to the Christians in Rome is his masterpiece (N. T. Wright, *Romans for Everyone*, p. xii). It was written somewhere between 57 and 59 AD when Nero ruled in Rome. It was while Paul was in Corinth, towards the end of his third missionary trip, that the great Apostle to the Gentiles penned his message to the Romans (D. Stuart Briscoe, *The Communicator's Commentary*, p. 16).

In 16 chapters, 433 verses, and 7,111 words, Paul, writing under the guidance of the Holy Spirit, sets out a reasoned, systematic, and comprehensive presentation of the Christian gospel. In preparation for our series of evangelistic meetings, starting on April 26, I invite everyone to begin reading (or read again) this amazingly inspired Book of the Bible.

#### HEALTH & NUTRITION TIPS FROM THE HEALTH MINISTRY: Lower your Blood Sugar: This week we'll continue to discuss foods that lower blood glucose level.

- 1. Eat more fiber. Fiber reduces glucose spikes and slows down the digestion of carbohydrates. The fiber that is most effective in reducing blood glucose is soluble fiber. This fiber forms a gel-like substance which makes it more difficult for glucose to be released. Soluble fiber is found in most plant foods, but high amounts are found in beans and legumes; seeds like chia and flax; nuts like almonds, hazelnuts, and chestnuts; vegetables like brussels sprouts, kale, and sweet potato; fruit like avocado, apples, and pears; and grains like buckwheat.
- Another component of some plant foods that help reduce blood sugar levels and improve insulin sensitivity is resistant starch. Resistant starch is a type of carbohydrate that cannot be digested by the body but instead feeds healthy bacteria in your gut and acts in a similar manner as fiber. The higher the amount of resistant starch consumed, the lower your blood sugar. Foods high in resistant starch are green bananas, lentils, chickpeas, and beans. Foods like potatoes can also have high amounts of resistant starch if they are refrigerated for 24 hours and then consumed in salads but not reheated too much.


