Superfoods: Coconuts: Coconut Oil: Coconut oil can improve skin and hair health and appearance. It can be used as a face cleanser, makeup remover, sun screen, and a protective barrier from external factors. It can be used to support the skin of sufferers of eczema, psoriasis, dandruff and dermatitis due to its anti-inflammatory properties. Its antimicrobial properties will help with conditions of fungal or bacterial overgrowth. Coconut oil has also been found to protect the hair against damage, and reduce breakage. There is some evidence that it also promotes hair growth. For best results, use a small amount on dry areas or apply it to hair before washing. As with any skincare product, patch-test first to check for irritation.
